HEALTH AND SAFETY

Managers are responsible for:

- 1. Observing, and enforcing through supervision, appropriate standards for health and safety compliance.
- 2. Developing, implementing and continuously improving safe work systems through consultation with employees and contractors.
- 3. Ensuring that safe workplaces and safe plant and equipment are provided and monitored.
- 4. Providing information, training and supervision to ensure employees and contractors are able to carry out their work safely.
- 5. Recording and investigating accidents and incidents and implementing corrective actions.
- 6. Promptly and effectively dealing with injury and ill health through rehabilitation programs.

Employees are responsible for:

- 1. Ensuring that by their acts or omissions they do not put at risk their own health and safety or that of other employees, contractors or the public.
- 2. Co-operating with management in all aspects of health, safety and security including the proper use of equipment, following procedures, completing training, reporting incidents and participating in rehabilitation programs.

Contractors & Visitors are responsible for:

- 1. Taking care of their own health and safety and that of other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions.
- 2. Being aware of and complying with applicable health, safety and security regulations, policies, procedures and practices.
