CLUB POLICY

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Managers are responsible for:

1. Observing, and enforcing through supervision, appropriate standards for health and safety compliance.
2. Developing, implementing and continuously improving safe work systems through consultation with employees and contractors.
3. Ensuring that safe workplaces and safe plant and equipment are provided and monitored.
4. Providing information, training and supervision to ensure employees and contractors are able to carry out their work safely.
5. Recording and investigating accidents and incidents and implementing corrective actions.
6. Promptly and effectively dealing with injury and ill health through rehabilitation programs.

Employees are responsible for:

1. Ensuring that by their acts or omissions they do not put at risk their own health and safety or that of other employees, contractors or the public.
2. Co-operating with management in all aspects of health, safety and security including the proper use of equipment, following procedures, completing training, reporting incidents and participating in rehabilitation programs.

Contractors & Visitors are responsible for:

1. Taking care of their own health and safety and that of other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions.
2. Being aware of and complying with applicable health, safety and security regulations, policies, procedures and practices.
